Beginning Sunday, Sept. 13, St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Oakwood will return to its regular worship schedule in our newly restored Sanctuary. Worship services are held Sunday mornings at 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m., and on Wednesday mornings at 9:15 a.m. On Wednesday evenings, everyone is welcome to meet in the Chapel of the Holy Spirit for Evening Prayer at 6 p.m.

53 Park Avenue opens for business

The Kettering Moraine Oakwood Chamber of Commerce performed a ribbon cutting for a newly renovated office building located at 53 Park Avenue in Oakwood. The ribbon cutting was held on Tuesday, Aug. 18, 2009. Mayor Judy Cook, as well as members of city staff, KMO Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors and Chamber staff were in attendance.

The office building, located across from the City of Oakwood building, was originally built in the mid-1950's. It has served as an antique store and a dentist office in past years. Seeing that there was a need to update the building for modern-day use, its new owners took the opportunity to completely renovate the interior and exterior of the building.

After replacing the heating

and air, repairing the leaky roof, installing new windows and wiring it for wireless Internet among many other updates, the building is ready for rent. There are approximately 4,000 square feet of space available for rent and will be finished to suit.
